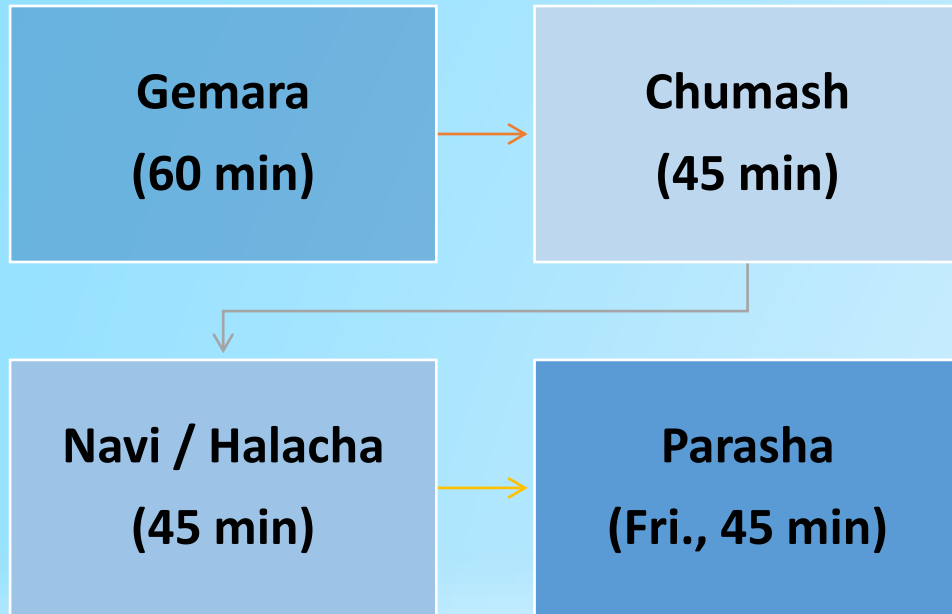
OSSD: Ontario Secondary School Diploma Courses

- Guidelines of Ontario Ministry of Education (including Literacy Test)
- Courses will be university preparatory (Academic, 4U, 4M)
- 30-32 Credits (30 is the minimum required for OSSD)
- Administrative guidance for University/College applications
- Registration with OUAC (for university application)

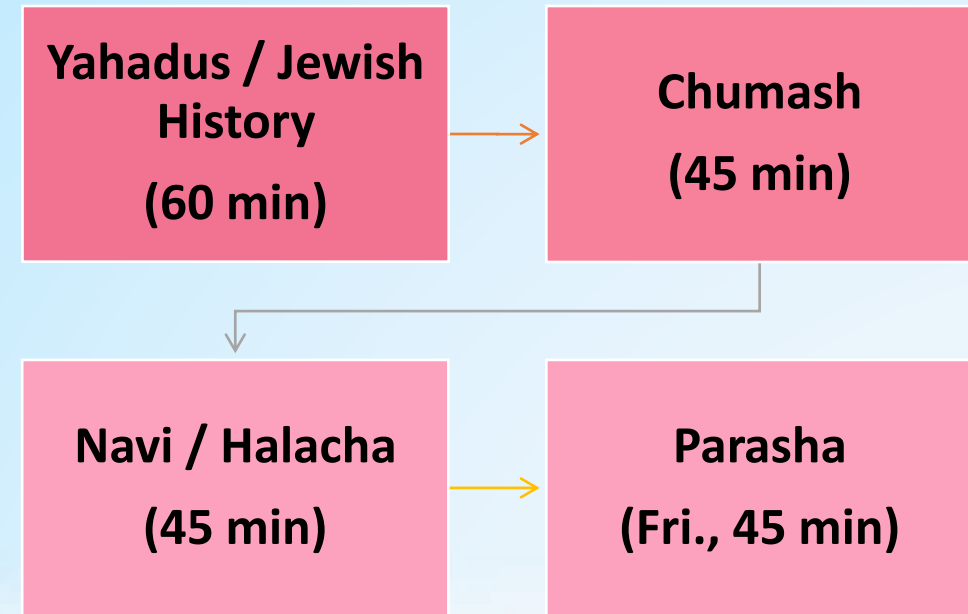
FULL JUDAIC CURRICULUM: 2.5 hours a day of Judaics

AFTER SCHOOL:

- Mishmar
- After school high school learning programs
- Sunday Gemara for fathers/sons
- Sunday learning for mothers/daughters



FULL JUDAIC CURRICULUM: 2.5 hours a day of Judaics



MISHMAR

- Once / twice a week program (girls, boys separately)
- Interesting topic (Parsha, Halacha, Gemara)



NIGHTLY HIGH SCHOOL LEARNING (Optional)

- Four days a week
- Three classes after school (45 min – 60 min each)
 - **Extension Program:** Extra session of Gemara or Chumash (YHSO students, or students with developed background)
 - **After School Program:** Judaics for public school HS students with less Judaic background, and students with special needs
 - **Reach Ahead:** Chumash / Navi / Halacha (7/8 grade students without prerequisite background, seeking entry to YHSO)

FULL JUDAIC CURRICULUM: 2.5 hours a day of Judaics



SUNDAY LEARNING

- Alternating Sunday mornings (mother/daughter and father/son)
- Davening and Breakfast
- Learning Program:
 - Gemara for fathers/sons
 - Advanced Halacha or Parsha for mothers/daughters

PHILOSOPHY/HASKAFA: Modelled after North American yeshiva high schools (boys) and all-girls high schools of smaller communities.



✓ **DRESS CODE:** For boys and girls

✓ **GENDER SEPARATION:** For boys and girls (all classes and activities). School will be in TDSO building.

✓ **DAVENING TWICE A DAY:** Shacharis and Mincha minyanim for boys twice a day, davening for girls twice a day
